

## **Statement on Palestine**

In the name of God the Merciful and Compassionate "Surely Allah doesn't change a people until they change what's in themselves." (Qur'an 13:11)

10.19.2023. Over the past two weeks, heart-wrenching images and news have unfolded out of occupied Palestine. The American Muslim Community Foundation (AMCF) is deeply disturbed as we witness a genocide happening before our eyes. The humanitarian situation is worsening in each passing moment with innumerable breaches of international law being relentlessly perpetrated against the 2.3 million innocent civilians of Gaza including continuous bombings, forced displacement and a complete blockading of basic necessities such as water, food and electricity.

Our concern moves us to act. As stewards of Muslims values and ethics, we have an imperative to stand against oppression, injustice and attacks on innocent human lives wherever they happen. We at AMCF join the voices of countless organizations across the U.S. and around the world calling for an immediate ceasefire and halt to violence against innocent civilians. AMCF joins 70+ organizations in urging President Biden to call for immediate ceasefire, protection of civilians, and an end of anti-Muslim, anti-Arab, and anti-Palestinian rhetoric.

As a community foundation that supports dozens of humanitarian nonprofits ready to help in Gaza, but denied access, we also call for an immediate opening of safe passages into Gaza allowing for the transfer of desperately-needed life-saving supplies.

Everyone has a role to play in standing up for justice and the sanctity of human life in this moment. To the many thoughtful action lists that have been circulated in our community, we add ours tailored specifically for our donors and nonprofit partners.

## **Individual Calls to Action:**

- 1. **Make heartfelt duaa** (supplication) and pray. As human beings, we all collectively are experiencing the anguish of witnessing unspeakable injustice and the ongoing loss of numerous innocent lives in our time. Nonetheless, our faith in the power of prayer (dua) remains unshaken. We know that Allah is All-Seeing, All-Hearing and is in control of all affairs with His Infinite Wisdom. Let us turn to Him for strength and aid. See <u>Islamic Relief</u> and <u>Yaqeen Institute</u> for resources.

- 3. **Contact your representatives** to voice your concern for innocent civilians at risk of imminent death in Gaza and ask them to support an immediate ceasefire. You



can use templates such as this one from CAIR, Emgage Action, Americans for Justice in Palestine (AJP), and others being circulated in your networks or write your own message. In addition to email messages, make daily phone calls to your representatives offices and ask to speak with staff members to leave your comments.

- 4. Get informed about your rights related to speaking out, attending protests and rallies, advocacy and how to respond to bias, discrimination or Islamophobia in the context of the workplace, university, school and other settings relevant to your daily life. Palestine Legal, Muslim Legal Fund and CAIR are both great resources on these topics.
- 5. **Thank our allies** in the community who have been raising awareness about the situation in Gaza.
- 6. **Take care of your well-being**. This is a difficult time for any concerned human being, but we must not forget to take care of ourselves and our families physically, mentally and emotionally so we can continue our journey for justice together. Maristan, Sukoon and Cornerstone Counseling are all great resources on mental health for the Muslim community- check out their social media in particular. Also check out Noor Kids for resources for talking to children about the current events.
