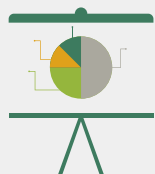

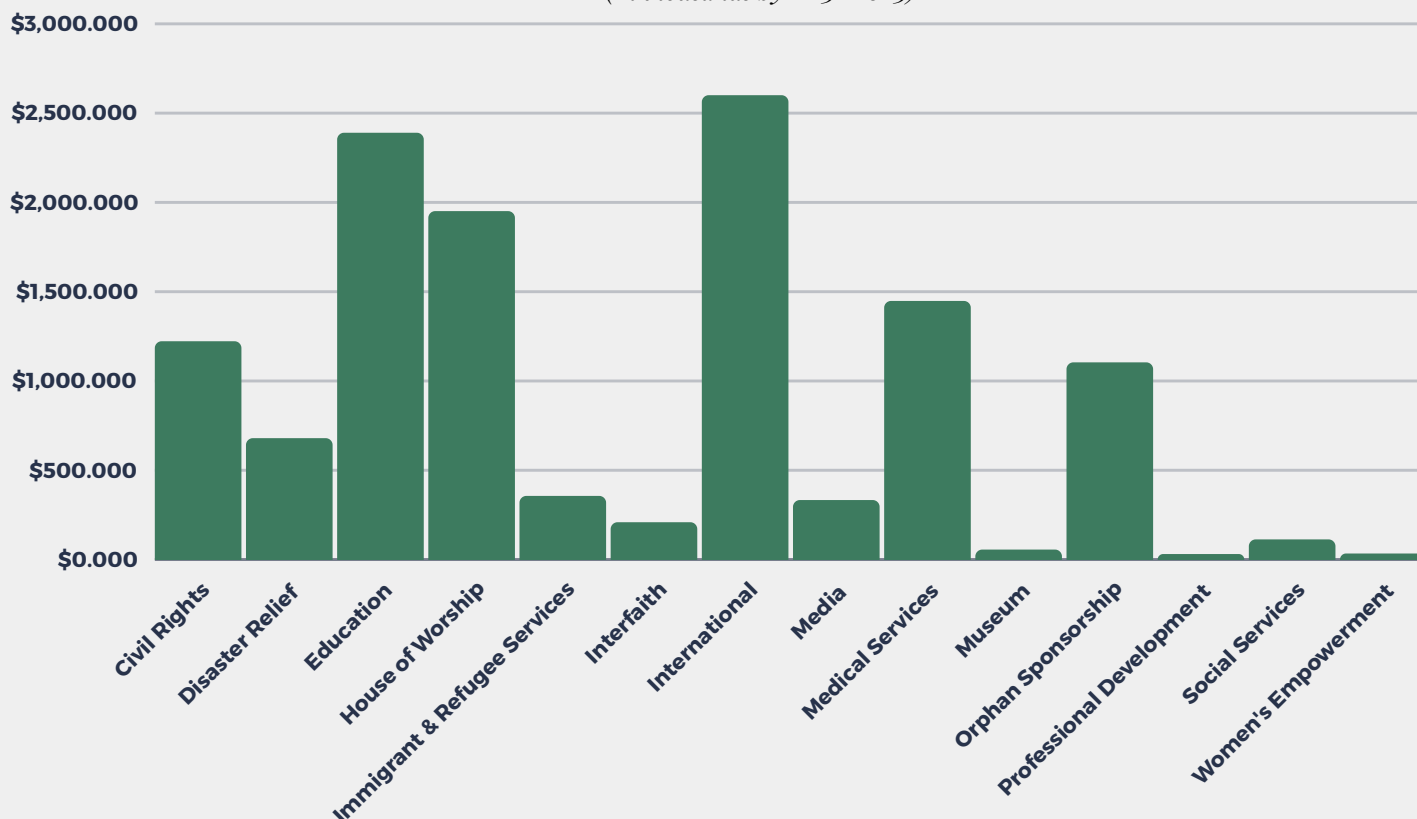

Donor Advised Funds

A DAF is a giving vehicle that provides you with immediate tax benefits & allows you to support your charities of choice through grant recommendations on your own timetable. You can invest your balance, name the fund after a loved one, and pass it on generation to generation.

Giving Circles

A Giving Circle is a form of philanthropy where groups of individuals donate their money & time to a pooled fund, deciding together which nonprofit or project to fund. This increases awareness of & engagement in issues covered by the charity. Give with your family & friends!

Endowments

An endowment is a financial resource, in the form of a donation to be used as an investment, which generates an annual return based on the principal of its assets (cash, stock, property, will, insurance, etc).

Since 2016, American Muslim Community Foundation has been hard at work transforming the landscape of Muslim philanthropy. At the same time, we recognize the need to achieve our own sustainability. Our founders had the vision to create a scalable fundraising model to support our work, implementing best practices of fundraising and nonprofit leadership to prevent donor fatigue.

AMCF was founded with a goal to reach our operational budget through administrative fees and general donations. Our strategy involves scaling to manage 1,000 DAFs, raising \$20,000,000 of assets under management, and grow our centralized endowment to \$5,000,000.
